

A nine week course in hand bookbinding. Students will have the opportunity to learn bookbinding and boxmaking techniques in a variety of historical and contemporary styles, and to use conventional and unconventional binding materials. There will also be a chance to develop a personal project in the latter stages. The course will be for a maximum of 8 students and will be run by Ina Baumeister at Book Works Studio.
